 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said McPherson his heirs  
 and assigns in fee simple the following described lands lying  
 and being in the State and Comf of said said and known and  
 described as follows to wit on the plan of the town of Milton  
 half acre lots 2-4-6-8 and acre lots No. 11, 12, 15, 16, 19, 20, & 23 & 24  
 all lying on East bank of Black water River opposite the town  
 of Milton also 1/2 acre of land lying in town of Milton on Black  
 water River and being the same conveyed to Benjamin Marshall and  
 William Mack by Benjamin Storringer also a lot of land on Black  
 Water River containing 1/2 and once occupied as a United States Store  
 house also one undivided half of a lot which G. S. Amos  
 purchased from William Mack and conveyed to said Benjamin  
 Marshall said lot commencing on Wellington Street 70 feet south  
 of the north East corner of said lot and running south with  
 said Milling Street 79 1/2 feet thence running west the depth of
