This indenture made this first day of September A.D. one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Egebel E Simpson and Benjamin Wright Executors of the last will and Testament of Joseph Forsyth on the one part and James Creamy in the other part Witnesseth that whereas pursuant to an order of the Hon. the Judge of the Circuit Court of Santa Rosa County Florida. the said party of the first part did this day offer at public sale on the premises the right title and interest of the said heirs of Joseph Forsyth deceased aforesaid in and to the undivided one sixth part of certain tracts of land lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and known and described as follows. To wit Lot Number six (6) in section Number ten (10) and lot number five (5) in section number eleven (11) of Township Number one (1) Range twenty eight North and West together with all the improvements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, Consisting of a Steam Saw Mill Planing Mill and other buildings and the machinery therein contained also the undivided one sixth part of all and sundry tracts of land purchased and entered from time to time by and for the late firm of Forsyth and Simpson for the use and purposes of said Mill and whereas at the public sale aforesaid the said James Creamy was the highest and best bidder for the same and purchased the same for the sum of Six thousand six hundred and sixteen dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Now therefore for and in consideration of the premises said Egebel E Simpson and Benjamin Wright Executors as aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James Creamy the undivided one sixth part of the lands Tenements and hereditaments heretofore described to have and to hold to him the said James Creamy his heirs and assigns forever for the purposes whereof the parties of the first part have hereunto set hands and seals the day and date of the said
