This Deed of Conveyance made this twenty ninth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four Between George Perry of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida of the first part and Henry Slaback of the County of Columbia and same State of the second part Witness that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars of good and lawful money of the United States and also fifteen thousand brick of merchantable quality the said money to him in hand paid and the said brick to be hereafter delivered by the said party of the second part the receipt of said money is hereby acknowledged and confessed both bargained granted sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain grant sell give off convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following described lands situate lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa of Florida known and distinguished as the east half of the north east quarter of section number (35) thirty five in Township number (2) two of Range number (28) twenty eight North and West Containing Eighty acres and nine hundredths of one acre (80.09) Also the West Half of the north West quarter of Section number (36) thirty six in Township number (2) two of Range number (28) twenty eight North and West Containing Eighty acres all in the district of lands of the United States subject to sale at the land office in Tallahassee and State aforesaid Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the revenues and revenues remainder and remainder rents issues and profits thereof and also all the Estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity of in and to the above bargained premises with the said hereditaments and appurtenances To have and to hold the said bargained and described premises as above particularly mentioned and described to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever And the said party of the first part for himself his heirs Executors and administrator do hereby covenant warrant and defend the said party of the second part in the title and quiet enjoyment of the premises hereby conveyed In Testimony whereof the said party of the first part has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written
