under a private examination made of her by me and separate and apart
from her said husband she acknowledged to me under said examination
that she executed the foregoing Renunciation and Relinquishment of

her said husband and that the same are her own acts and deeds

of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars
to her in hand paid the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged
Cordelia W Parlyth has granted bargained and sold and by these
present doth grant bargain and sell to Ezekiel E Simpson as
Trustee of the late firm of Parlyth and Simpson (consisting of
the following surviving partners of said firm Ezekiel E Simpson
Benjamin Anorman John A Simpson and Benjamin Thompson the
following described property "to wit" a lot or piece of ground in
Bagdad Santa Rosa County being the South East corner of a subdivi-
sion in the plan of Bagdad made to Joseph Parlyth of Bagdad
and one fourth acre beginning at said corner and running
North about two hundred and eighty two feet to an avenue
through the grounds then met about one hundred and ninety
seven feet to a fence dividing said grounds from the premises
truly conveyed thence along the line of said fence directly
said grounds to the southern bound thereof and thence about
one hundred and ninety seven feet at the place of beginning
to have and to hold to the said Ezekiel E Simpson as trustee
as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever In witness
