Simpson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Ezekiel C. Simpson his heirs and assigns the following property situated in the County of Santa Rosa and State of Florida "to wit" Lot No. two (2) Block No. twenty five (25) in the plan of town of Milton and that portion of Lot No. two (2) Block Nineteen (19) purchased from the Hardin Estate April 14th 1860 and Lots one (1) and two (2) Block twenty two (22) and Lots one & three (1 & 3) Block thirty (30) and that part of Lot five (5) Sec. three (3) T. one (1) R. twenty eight (28) & that purchased from George D. Fisher administrator of Anna Maria Land down & containing 1 1/3 acres also one acre of land adjoining same bought from Dillon Jordan March 17th 1858 also half acre of land adjoining above bought from J. M. Sandrum June 24th 1857 the two last mentioned parcels constituting the home place now occupied by the above grantors Joseph H.
