Witnesseth that the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) to them in hand paid the payment whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell to the party of the second part all the right title and interest which they jointly and severally at this writing may have or possess in law or equity to the following described lot or tract of land viz: The South West quarter (14) of the South East quarter (14) of Section seventeen (17) Township Two (2) Range twenty seven (27) North and West containing forty (40) acres more or less which was entered at the land office at Tallahassee by the late Robt. McKeenrod said land lying and being on the tributary waters of Black Water River in the County of Santa Rosa and State of Florida be witness whereof the parties have this day first above written annexed their hands and affixed their seals
