 unto the said Cobb his heirs executors and administrators
 The condition of the above bill of sale that is this day made executed
 and delivered by said Prosser to said Cobb is such that whereas
 said Prosser is indebted to said Cobb in the sum of one hundred
 and thirty two dollars with interest thereon since the 29th day of
 January last the above instrument is intended as a Mortgage to
 secure the payment of the same Now if the said Prosser shall
 well and truly pay said indebtedness with the interest thereon
 within sixty days from this date then this obligation and bill of sale
 to be void else to remain in full force and virtue In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2^d
 day of December A.D. 1869 The words "also and carry log" and the
 word "two" were interlined before a mortgage was executed
