 Certificate } Thomas Henry Slabick of Santa Rosa County Florida has  
 12 13163 } deposited in the general Land office of the United States a  
 certificate of the Register of the land office at Tallahassee whereby it  
 appears that full payment has been made by the said Henry Slabick  
 according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2<sup>d</sup> of April  
 1820, entitled 'an act making further provisions for the sale of  
 public lands' for the Lots numbered two three six and seven of section  
 thirty five in Township two North of Range twenty eight West  
 in the district of lands subject to sale at Tallahassee Florida con-  
 taining one hundred and ninety one acres and seven eight hun-  
 dredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the survey  
 of the said lands returned to the general Land office by the  
 surveyor general, which said tract has been purchased by  
 the said Henry Slabick. Now know ye that the United States  
 of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity  
 with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided  
 have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant  
 unto the said Henry Slabick and to his heirs the said tract above  
 described to have and to hold the same together with all the  
 rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever  
 nature thereunto belonging unto the said Henry Slabick and to  
 his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof James  
 Buchanan, President of the United States of America have  
 caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general  
 Land office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City  
 of Washington the first day of December in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven and of the Independence of
