Whereas I John W. Butler as Sheriff of Santa Rosa County Florida  
by virtue of an execution issued from the Magistrates Court of said  
County by Neil McMillen Justice of the Peace on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November  
AD 1867 in a cause wherein Mendel A. Fisher was Plaintiff and G. B.  
Dycus was defendant levied the same on the West half of Section two  
in Township three North Range twenty seven West as the property of said  
Dycus on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December AD 1869 and whereas afterwards trials  
on the first Monday in February the same being the seventh day of said month  
after advertising the sale of the same for thirty days according to law I  
offered said property for sale to the highest bidder for cash to satisfy said  
execution and whereas at said sale one W. J. Collins became the purchaser  
thereof for the sum of thirty dollars he being the highest and best bidder  
therefor it was therefore by the said John W. Butler as Sheriff as aforesaid  
for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars to me in hand paid  
by said Collins the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and Confirmed  
do hereby bargain sell and convey unto the said Collins all the right title  
and interest of the said Dycus in and to the aforementioned  
lands to have and to hold unto the said Collins his heirs & assigns in  
fee simple forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February AD 1870
