This Deed of Conveyance made this twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one = 1861 between William J. Kuper of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida of the first part and Pally Perry wife of George Perry of the same place of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars of good and lawfull money to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed has bargained granted sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents does bargain grant sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever the following described Town Lots or parcel of land situate lying and being in the town of Milton County and State aforesaid known and distinguished on the plan or plat of said town as Lots Number (1 & 3) One and three in Block Number (28) Twenty eight fronting respectively on Oak Street and Walton Street each containing One hundred feet front by one hundred feet in depth. It being considered that the said Pally Perry wife of the said George Perry as aforesaid shall by these presents take and receive the same absolutely and in fee simple as her separate and independent property in the same manner as she might do were she a "feme sole" with full power to dispose of the same by will or by joining her husband in the execution of a Deed to Convey the same absolutely or to Create a lien thereon by mortgage Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise apper-

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
