Know all Men by these Presents that: Whereas the Circuit Court for the County of Santakaw State of Florida in a cause wherein Richard Thackery and his wife Polly Thackery were Plaintiffs and John D. Vanborn and his wife Susan Vanborn was Defendants on the 19th day of June A.D. 1867 rendered a decree foreclosing the said John D. Vanborn and his wife Susan Vanborn and all persons claiming by through or under them of and from all equity of redemption in and to the following described real estate situate in said County estate in the town of Milton and known on the plan of said town as that part of lot No six (6) in Block number Nineteen (19) described thus Commencing at the North East corner of said Lot and running Southward along the margin of said Lot and Milling Street seventy feet thence Westwardly at right angles with said street and through said lot to the depth of a square half acre. Northwardly at right angles seventy feet on a line parallel with said Milling street thence Eastwardly on the line of said lot to place of beginning also lot No Seven in said Block Nineteen (19) - And whereas also the said Court by the said Decree ordered that the above described property be sold by a Master of the Court to satisfy the Contract Debt of the said Defdts to the said Plaintiffs on the first Monday in August after giving thirty days notice of the time & place of such sale And that Robert R. Sheppard be made the special Master to execute the said Decree And whereas afterwards to wit: on the 5th day of August A.D. 1867 that being the first Monday of said month after thirty days notice of the time and place of sale had been given in the manner prescribed by law the above described lots of land were sold at public outcry to the highest bidder before the Court House door in the town of Milton in said County and during the usual hours of sale And Polly Thackery wife of Richard Thackery having made the best & highest bid for the above described lots of land - The said Polly Thackery wife of Richard Thackery became the purchaser of all and
