 and by their presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the
 said party of the second part and to their heirs and assigns forever
 a certain Lot or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the
 County of Escambia on Black Water river and adjoining said river
 containing one half of an acre and being the same Lot and House
 which has recently been occupied by the United States as a Store-
 House Together with all and singular the hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and
 the reversion and reversions remainders and remainders next issues
 and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim
 or demand whatsoever of the said party of the first part either
 in law or equity of in and to the above bargained premises with
 the said hereditaments and appurtenances To have and to
 hold the said premises above particularly mentioned and
 described to the said party of the second part their heirs and
 assigns forever And the said party of the first part for them-
 selves and their heirs doth hereby covenant to warrant and
 defend the said party of the second in the title and quiet
