State of Florida in a certain cause depending in said Court
wherin Egbert S. Simpson and Benjamin D. Wright as executors of the
last will and testament of Joseph Wright deceased are
complainants and William W. Harrison and his wife Ann
Maria Harrison were respondents on the 27th day of October
AD 1866 rendered a decree for closing the said William W.
Harrison and his wife Ann Maria Harrison and all persons
claiming by through or under them of and from all the equity
of redemption in and to the following described real estate

five on Elmira Street and Lot number Two (2) Corner

described property be sold by a master of this Court to

ants on the first Monday of any month after thirty days

and whereas afterwards on the sixth day of March AD 1868
that being the first Monday of the said month after thirty days
notice of the time and place of such sale had been given in
the manner prescribed by law the above described lot of lands
with all the improvements and appurtenances was sold at pub-
lic outcry to the highest bidder before the Court House door in
the town of Milton in said State and County during the usual
hours of sale and Mrs Ann Maria Harrison having made the
highest and best bid for the said property became the
purchaser thereof at and for the sum of One Thousand

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
