thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and  
to hold the above described real estate unto the said Simpson  
& Co their heirs and assigns in fee simple forever

warrant and defend the said Simpson & Co their heirs  
and assigns in the title and quiet enjoyment of the  
premises hereby conveyed
