 and purposes therein mentioned. And the said Julia wife as  
 aforesaid being examined by me separate and apart from her  
 said husband acknowledged that she joined her husband in  
 the execution of the foregoing deed for the purpose of renouncing  
 and relinquishing her right of dower of in and to say and all  
 dower in the lands mentioned in the foregoing deed freely  
 and voluntarily and without any compulsion constraint  
 apprehension or fear of or from her said husband and that  
 the same is her own free act and deed.
