Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars of good and lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is truly confessed and acknowledged have bargained granted sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever The following described property situate lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa and in the town of Milton to wit two Lots known and designated on the plot or map of said town as Lots No. Eight & Nine (8 & 9) in Block No. Nineteen (19) with a front on Hilling Street from the corner of Grace Street of seventy feet (70) and extending back to Elvira Street the same width It being conditioned that the said Julia wife of the said John as aforesaid shall by these presents take and receive the same absolutely and in fee simple as her separate and distinct property in the same manner as she might do were she a feme sole with full power to dispose of the same by will or by joining her said husband in the execution a deed to convey the same absolutely or create a lien thereon by mortgage, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and several remainders and several and sole issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity of in and to the same
