


said party of the second part and their successors in office forever in trust that they shall erect and build or cause to be erected and built thereon a house or place of worship for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church South according to the rules and discipline which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the ministers and preachers of the said Church at their general Conference and in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times forever here after permit each Minister and preacher belonging to the said Church as shall from time to time be duly authorized by the General Conference of the Ministers and preachers of the Methodist Episcopal Church South or by the annual Conference authorized by the said General Conference to preach and expound Gods holy writ therein and the said party of the first doth by these presents warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned and described lot or piece of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto them the said party of the second part and their successors chosen and appointed as before said from the Claim or Claims of them the said party of the first part, their heirs and assigns, and from claim or Claims of all persons who ever: Provided nevertheless that if the said lot or piece of land ever cease to be occupied and used for a church and for preaching purpose as herein before mentioned and provided for them and in that event the title to the said lot or piece of land hereby conveyed shall revert to and rest in the said party of the first part as completely and fully to all intents and purposes as if the deed of conveyance had never been made executed and delivered
