This Indenture of Mortgage made this ninth day of May in A.D. 1872 by and between the Pensacola & Louisville Rail Road Company a Corporation created under the law of the State of Florida party of the first part and J. W. Black and E. E. Simpson & R. D. Wright as guardians of Josephine Forsyth party of the second part Witnesseth: Whereas the said party of the first part being indebted to the said party of the second part in the sum of Sixty seven Thousand and eighty five Dollars and to have made to the party of the second part its ten several promissory notes as follows = One for six thousand seven hundred & eighty five dollars payable to J. W. Black or bearer in one year One for six thousand seven hundred & eighty five dollars payable to E. E. Simpson & R. D. Wright as guardians of Josephine Forsyth or bearer in one year - but with a provision that if the interest on all the ten notes herein mentioned is promptly paid at the expiration of one year after their date the time for payment of this note shall be extended one year & so on.
