into the business of getting saw logs in the County of Santa
Rosa in the State of Florida and whereas Joseph Ellinger
Merchant of the town of Milton State and County aforesaid
agrees to furnish from time to time the necessary supplies
for carrying on the said business of getting saw logs I do
know all men by these presents that we the said Clark
Prosser and A. J. Colley for and in consideration of
furnishing of said supplies necessary to carry on the
said business of getting saw logs in said County do hereby
make deed and constitute unto the said Joseph Ellinger
his heirs and assigns a lien upon all the said logs so got
out by us by virtue of said advanced funds and in accor-
dance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida
entitled an act to enable indigent persons to obtain credit
and to secure their funds" approved Feby 16th 1870 and
for the consideration aforesaid and the further sum of five
dollars to us in hand paid by said Ellinger we hereby
bargain grant sell and convey unto the said Ellinger his
