

I may get in consequence of said advances in accordance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled an act to Enable indigent persons to obtain credit and to secure the lender approved February 16 AD 1870 and for the consideration aforesaid and the further consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me in hand paid by said Joseph Ollinger the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Ollinger his heirs and assigns the following described property to wit: One Log Cab and three yoke of Oxen said Oxen as thus described One white with a red head one a frosty sided steer one with black sides and white back and belly one blue frosty colored one black and white pied and one a yellow and white pied steer To have and to hold the above described property unto the said Joseph Ollinger his heirs and assigns forever Get upon this condition that if I the said J F Blackman shall pay to the said Ollinger within six months from the date hereof the amount advanced by said Ollinger then this Mortgage to be of no effect else to remain in full force and effect In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1872
