Marshall partners trading and doing business under the name and style of Howell and Marshall the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey deliver unto the said Howell and Marshall the following described personal property to wit: One Log cut six feet high four inches in the head with wooden axle one Log cut three inches in the head with iron axle also the following described oxen to wit: One a Brown Ox, one white, one Red sided, one Speckled, one Black & White peddled and one Broad horn speckled ox The two last and the white ox being the ones bought by me from John Crosswell all the others bought of Eben Thompson To have and to hold the above described property unto the said Howell & Marshall their heirs and assigns forever Upon the condition that whereas I the said P Peacock am indebted to said Howell & Marshall for supplies furnished me by them from time to time to compare the business of getting saw logs in said County now when the said Howell & Marshall shall be well and truly paid for all such
