Witnesses that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five dollars of good and lawful money of the United States of America to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt is hereby acknowledged and confessed have bargained granted sold conveyed conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain grant sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following portion of a lot or parcel of ground situate lying and being in the town aforesaid known and distinguished as the west half (except sixty seven feet in depth in the south west and east to Henry Nettles) of Lot Number (2) two on a plat of Lots laid off by John McCarter then County surveyor for George W. Hamilton on the south half of Lot one in Fraction Section Three of Township 1 north of Range twenty eighth west containing one half of one acre (less the sixty seven feet aforesaid) together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest
