 Know all men by these presents that I J. C. Wilkins of the County and State of aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars &c in hand paid by Joseph Allinger Merchant of the Town of Maitland State and County of aforesaid have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns the following described property To wit: One Yoke of Oxen both Black and white yoked each about six years old and being the yokes I purchased from William Parrish to have and to hold the said yoke of oxen unto the said Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns forever but upon the condition that whereas I the said J. C. Wilkins am indebted to the said Joseph Allinger for provisions furnished me from time to time for the purpose of carrying on the business of getting Shingles in said County Now if all indebtedness in consequence of the furnishing of said provisions shall well and truly be paid by me then this mortgage to be null and void Else to remain in full force and effect And the better to secure the said Allinger for the advances for the purpose aforesaid I do hereby make and create unto the said Joseph Allinger a lien upon the shingles that I now have on hand and all the shingles I may get in consequence of said advances under an act passed by the Legislature of Florida entitled an act to enable indigent persons to obtain credit and to secure the lender approved February 16th 1870.
