And said McCobb in the further warranty of said Kuper hereby files a mortgage lien on the timber seen & under the terms of the contract of payment of advances

This agreement made and entered into the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1872 between McCobb of Santa Rosa County Fla and Wm J. Kuper of Milton Fla. Witnesses that the said McCobb has hereby sold and agree to deliver to the said William J. Kuper at Perry Pass Florida during the ensuing season the following Pitch Pine Timber to say: One hundred & fifty to two hundred No. 1 Heavy Timber all he may get at the following scale of prices to wit: 14 cents per cubic foot for timber averaging 100 feet and classing B<sup>1</sup> load up with half cent less on timber classing B<sup>2</sup> and with half a cent advance or deduction for each five feet increase or decrease in the average In case any timber is delivered under "B. one", it is not to be included in this scale of prices; but Wm J. Kuper is to have the option of taking it at the market price - Wm J. Kuper hereby agrees to advance to the said McCobb - from time to time such reasonable sums as may be needed to manufacture and haul said timber and raft it to the market for which advances he is to pay the usual interest and commissions of any balance due upon timber delivered after payment of the advances, is to be settled in cash and said McCobb hereby gives to William Kuper a lien and mortgage as security for such advances upon all timber as fast as gotten out, whereas it may be and do hereby authorize William J. Kuper or his agent in case of any accident to the said McCobb or whenever he may think it necessary for his security to take possession of and brand the said timber whenever it may be and get it to the market leaving the final settlement of accounts with him or his representative until the timber reaches the market. It is also agreed and understood that in case of any hidden defect
