Whereas James M. Cobb of Santa Rosa County in the State of Florida is being furnished from time to time with the necessary supplies for carrying on the log or timber business by each Chadwick and James P. Black partners doing business under the name and style of Chadwick & Black and whereas the said James M. Cobb is desirous of securing to the said Chadwick & Black payment for the advances he made and from time to time will make to him the said Cobb for the purpose aforesaid. Now know all men by these presents that I James M. Cobb for the consideration aforesaid do hereby make and create in to the said Chadwick & Black a lien on all the logs & timber that I may get out in consequence of said advances under and by virtue of any act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled an act to enable indigent persons to obtain credit and to secure the Lender approved February 16th 1870 the price for said logs or timber to be as follows: all averaging twenty five feet to be five cents per cubic foot all averaging thirty feet to be five and one half cents per cubic foot all averaging thirty five feet to be six and one half cents per cubic foot and all averaging forty feet to be seven and one half cents per cubic foot & be delivered in Yellow Water River and whereas the said James M. Cobb has this day given his certain promissory note to the said Chadwick & Black for the sum of Two hundred dollars payable from the date hereof three months. Now it is understood and agreed by the said Cobb that one fourth of the amount produced by said Cobb shall go in liquidation of said promissory note monthly.
