claim, unto the said Charles N. Johnson and his heirs and assigns
forever, all our and each of our right, title, interest, estate,
claim and demand both at law and in equity and as well in
possessions as in expectancy of in and to all that parcel of
land lying in the State of Florida Santa Rosa County, known
as the Ghent place where Manuel Ghent lived being in Section
(34) Thirty four Township (2) Two North of Range (28) Twenty
eight W. S. E. of Min. Range containing five acres
more or less, with an undivided singular householders and ap-
purtenances thereto belonging.
