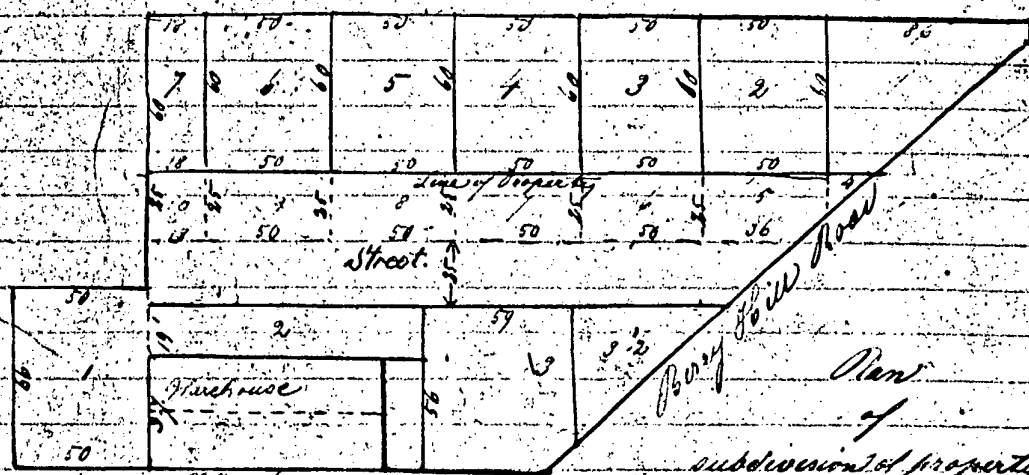

Know all men by these presents that I, William Gordon of the State of Florida and County of Santa Rosa for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars to me in hand paid by James Simpson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed to hereby bargain sell and convey unto the said James Simpson his heirs and assigns the following real Estate being and being in the State and County aforesaid and in the town of Milton and known as lot (4) four according to a subdivision of a lot in said town known as Simpson's Place here set:

To have and to hold unto the said James his heirs and assigns forever

The above instrument is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of two promissory notes of equal date sum of four hundred and fifty Dollars each one due six months and the other twelve months from date. Now if the said Gordon shall ever and truly pay said notes at maturity then this instrument to be void and to remain in full force and virtue.
