One of the papers was a bill of lading for lumber, and one was a bill of exchange. On the bill of lading it was said that the lumber was to be delivered to Joseph Ollinger, his heirs or assigns. On the bill of exchange it was said that the lumber was to be delivered to Joseph Ollinger, his heirs or assigns. On the 27th day of January 1874, I received from Joseph Ollinger, his heirs or assigns, the sum of \$1000.00 in full payment of the above mentioned bill of lading and bill of exchange. I have this day cancelled the same. Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of January 1874.

Joseph Ollinger, his heirs and assigns forever, yet upon this condition, that if the said S. B. Botts & Bros., shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said Joseph Ollinger, his heirs or assigns the amount, (viz the said Ollinger, by the said S. B. Botts & Bros. on account of said advances, when the same shall become due and a demand of payment thereof be made), that this Mortgage and lien to be cancelled and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full full and Effect. It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that this instrument of writing is given in lieu of a similar instrument signed by Mr. S. Botts and dated on the 24th day of October A. D. 1872 and to have the same effect and force in law and Equity to all intents and purposes as said instrument. In testimony whereof the said S. B.
