Whereas we A. Saunders and W. Saunders being desirous of carrying on the business of getting saw logs in Santa Rosa County in the State of Florida, and whereas Joseph Ollinger Merchant of the town of Milton State of Georgia aforesaid, agree to furnish us from time to time the necessary supplies to enable us to carry on said business of getting saw logs, and one the said A. Saunders & W. Saunders being desirous of securing the said Ollinger in the payment for said advances, so made by him and whereas said Ollinger the further to enable us the said A. & W. Saunders to carry on said business of getting saw logs, did indorse a certain promissory note given by us to Charles Conway, for the sum of two hundred and twenty five Dollars, and said note was given for the purchase of the team and log skid herein after mentioned Now know all men by these presents, that we A. Saunders and W. Saunders for the consideration aforesaid do make and create unto the said Joseph Ollinger, a lien upon all the saw logs we may get in consequence of said advances made from time to time unto the said Joseph Ollinger under and by virtue of an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida Entitled an Act to enable mortgagees to obtain credit and to secure the lenders approved Feb 16 1870. and for the consideration aforesaid and the further consideration of the sum of five Dollars to us in hand paid by the said Joseph Ollinger, we the said A. Saunders and W. Saunders, do hereby bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph Ollinger his heirs and assigns the following described personal property to wit: two yokes of Oxen and one log skid. The Oxen one thus described one red, one white with horns some off. One black with white spots and horns some off and one speckled with horns some off To have and to hold, the above described property unto the said Joseph Ollinger his heirs and assigns forever. Yet upon this condition that if we the said A. & W. Saunders shall will and truly pay the amount the said Joseph Ollinger by reason of said advances, then this mortgage to be of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October A.D. 1870.
