

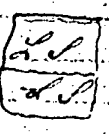

To have and to hold the above described real Estate unto the said Howells & Marshall their heirs and assigns in fee simple forever, and we the said Amos & Minto for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said Howells & Marshall their heirs and assigns in the title and quiet enjoyment of the premises hereby conveyed.
