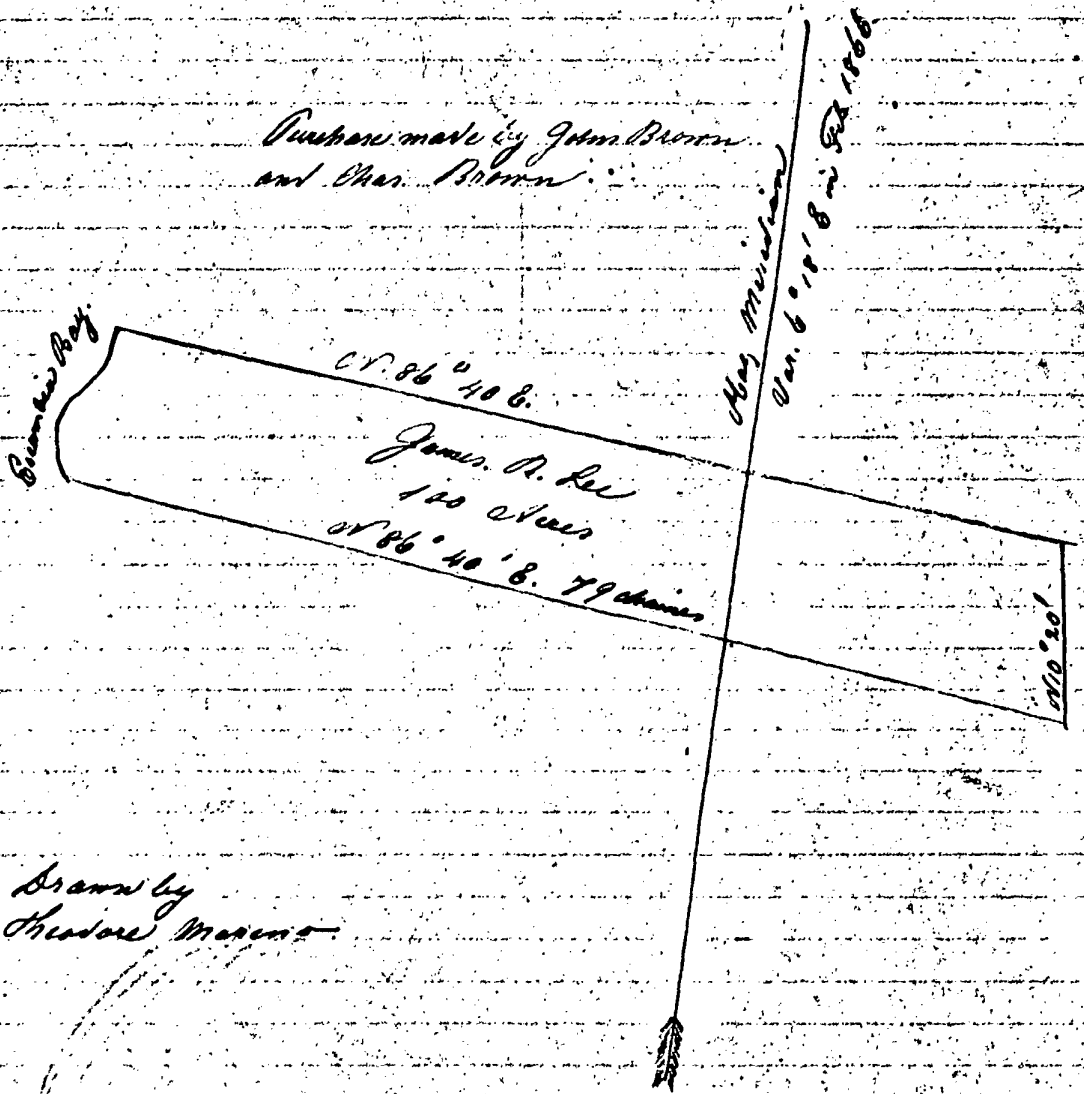


Dushaw made by John Brown

to
Napoleon Cook.

Shew all men by these presents, that the Board of Education of Florida under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida, entitled, 'An Act to establish a Uniform System of Common Schools and a University in this State,' approved January 30 1869 for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar and Twenty five cents per acre, to them in hand paid by Napoleon Cook of the county of Santa Rosa State of Florida, have granted, bargained, and sold and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Napoleon Cook and his heirs and assigns, forever the following described lands to wit: The north half of the lot numbered One of Section Fifteen in Township five (5) North of Range twenty nine west containing forty acres and lying and being in the county of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida to have and to hold unto the said Napoleon Cook
