Know all men by these presents, That the Trustees of the Posternal Improvement Fund, under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida, entitled "An Act to provide for and encourage a liberal system of internal improvements in this State." approved January 6<sup>th</sup> 1855, for and in witness of the sum of ninety cents per acre, to them in hand paid by Milligan & Chaffin of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Milligan and Chaffin and their heirs and assigns, forever, the following described land, to wit: The last half of the north West Quarter of Section, thirty eight in Township Five North Range Twenty nine West containing seventy nine and two acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida. To have and to hold unto the said Milligan and Chaffin and their heirs and assigns, forever in fee simple.

In testimony whereof a majority of said Trustees have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals, and have caused an impression of the seal of the Florida State Land Office to be made hereupon, at the Capital, in the City of Tallahassee, on this the second day of March A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy four.
