I do grant bargain, sell and convey to said S. D. Wilson the
following described property to wit: two black Steers branded

in the left with the hole torn nearly out; one dun Steer
marked crop in the right small horn feet in the left, two

the right and crop in the left and the other marked crop
and under mitr in the right and a crop in the left
one black Steer with a few white spots marked with
crop split and under bit, in the right and crop in the
left, one dark red steer with a few white spots, marked

under slope in the left, branded with S. one white
