Beal, of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida, have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Frederick O. Beal, and his heirs and assigns forever the following described Lands to wit: The South half of the North west quarter, and the North East quarter of the South west quarter of section twenty two in Township two North of Range Thirty West containing one hundred and twenty five acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida.  
To have and to hold unto the said Frederick O. Beal and his heirs and assigns, forever in fee simple.

In testimony whereof a majority of said Trustees have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals, and have caused an impression of the Seal of the Florida State Land Office to be made hereupon at the Capital in the City of Tallahassee, on this twenty fifth day of October A.D. eighteen hundred and seventy two
