66. J. G. Cobb to Amos & Minto

State of Florida
County of Santa Rosa

To all persons to whom these presents shall come, that whereas J. Seaborn & J. Cobb of the first part so bargain, sell and convey unto Amos & Minto of the second part; for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged one certain lot of Open Ground as the most known and one yellow and one blue, the right and title to said Acres, is lawfully vested in myself of the first part and no one else. To have and to hold to the said party of the second part, all right title interest or claim, now in me vested forever defending said right and title from all claims given whosoever coming unto the said party of the second part their heirs administrators and assigns. The condition of above omitted obligations is such that whereas J. Seaborn & J. Cobb did on the ninth day of May Eighteen hundred and seventy four execute unto the said Amos & Minto my promissory note for the sum of forty four \$⁰⁰. Dollars. The said note to be paid within sixty days from the date hereof, then the above obligation to be void otherwise to stand in full force and said property to be delivered unto the said Amos & Minto they having full power to enter my premises and take said property in any place they may find it without further suit.
