I am informed by these Presents, that William Birds of
the city of Pensacola, County of Escambia and State of
Florida, hath been duly appointed assignee of the estate
of the above named Bankrupts of Milton in the County of
Santa Rosa and State of Florida who have been adjudged
Bankrupts by decree of this Court. On March 9th 1867
I have registered in Bankruptcy in and for the District
aforesaid by virtue of the authority vested in me by
the fourteenth Section of the Act of Congress entitled "An
Act to establish a uniform System of Bankruptcy
throughout the United States" approved May 9th 1864, so
as to convey and assign to the said William Birds assignee
as aforesaid, all the estate, real and Personal, of the said
Crisler, Batchelor, Peely & Co. & William L. Crisler Bankrupts
including all Property, of whatever kind, of which he is
possessed, or in which they were interested, or entitled to have,
on the thirty first day of January A.D. 1867 one thousand eight
hundred and sixty eight. together with all his Deeds, Books
and Papers relating thereto, saving and excepting such Property
as is exempted from the operation of this assignment.
To have and to hold all the foregoing premises to the said
William Birds and to his heirs forever. In Trust never-
theless for the use and purposes and with the powers and
subject to the conditions and limitations, prescribed
and set forth in said Act.
