 property to wit: two yokes of Oxen - One yoke both

 the title to which we do hereby warrant, to have and
 to hold the same unto the said Joseph Olinger his
 heirs and assigns forever. Yet upon this condition that
 if the said A. B. Cotton and Allen Saunders shall
 pay to the said Olinger his heirs and assigns the
 full and just amount that we may be indebted
 to said Olinger when thereunto requested then this
 instrument of writing to be cancelled the to remain
 in full force and effect
