Know all men by these presents that I
Mr. F. Williams being desirous of entering
in to and carrying on the business of getting Saw Logs in said
County and whereas Joseph Allinger merchant of the town of
Milton in said State and County agrees to furnish me the
said Mr. F. Williams from time to time with the necessary
provisions and supplies for carrying on said business and I the said
Mr. F. Williams being desirous of securing the said Allinger in
the payment of the said advances be made do hereby create
and make into the said Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns
a lien on all the logs so got by me under and by virtue of
an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled
an act to enable indigent persons to obtain credit and
to secure the same. approved February 16th 1870. and
the further to secure the said Allinger in the payment
for said advances I the said William F. Williams do
hereby bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Allinger his
heirs and assigns one yoke of Oxen this described one a
Dun colored Ox marked with crop and half rope in the
left Ear no mark in the right Brand figure 11 one
white Ox marked with crop and one bit in the right
Ear and split and corner bit in the left Ear Brand C 7
to have and to hold the said yoke of Oxen unto the said
Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns forever, yet upon
this condition if the said Allinger shall be punctually
paid for the advances so made to him from time to
time then this bill of sale to be cancelled, and it
is further agreed by the said advances that ten dollars
out of every one hundred dollars worth of said logs
shall be appropriated to the payment of an
account now due the said Allinger until the same
shall be settled.
