This indenture made and entered into this month day of June
 A.D. 1874 between J. W. Wright and Arthur J. Gunters
 partners trading under the name and style of George W.
 Wright & Co., and Geo. W. Wright and M. E. Wright
 his wife partners of the first part and Ebenezer Hubbard
 of the City of Escambia County of Wimmera State of
 Florida of the second part. Witnesseth that the said
 partners of the first part for and in consideration of the sum
 of twenty six thousand dollars to them on hand paid
 by the said party of the second part, at or before the
 unveiling and delivery of these presents, the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
 sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed,
 and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien,
 remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said
 party of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever
 the following, real and personal, to wit: to wit: the
 eastern portion of a tract of land situated on the Bay
 of Escambia in the County of Escambia State of Florida
 about nine miles or within the City of Pensacola
 & supposed about two hundred and one acres and being a
 part of a tract of land formerly owned by John Somers
 by him conveyed to William Webb, by said Webb to
 Willis, Mr. Raven and others and latterly to George W.
 Wright party hereto of the first part and in person is
 erected a steam saw mill with the mill race
 machinery and all tools implements and appurtenances
