Whereas J. B. Howell and William H. Marshall partners doing business under the firm name and style of Howell & Marshall in the town of Milton State of Florida have agreed to furnish me for the purpose of carrying on the business of getting Saw Logs or square timber (as I may deem proper) and whereas the said Howell & Marshall are now furnishing me with the said necessary supplies for carrying on said business and whereas I the said Samuel T. Stewart being desirous of securing to the said Howell & Marshall full payment for the advances so made, now have all men by these presents that I Samuel T. Stewart of the State of Florida do hereby give and create unto the said Howell and Marshall their heirs and assigns, a lien upon all the saw logs or square timber that I now have in possession or which I may hereafter obtain in consequence of said advances. This lien is made under and by virtue of an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida, entitled an Act to enable indigent persons to obtain credit and to secure the same approved February 16th A.D. 1870.
