consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars lawful money
the receipt, whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give
grant bargain sell and convey unto Silas Ferrigan his heirs
and assigns forever all that unsurveyed tract or parcel of land
in Section two and three of Township one Range twenty eight
North and west known and described in the official plat as
the Ferry, containing sixty acres and lying and being in
the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida, to have
and to hold the said granted and bargained premises with the
privileges and appurtenances thereof to him the said Silas
Ferrigan, his heirs and assigns forever in Fee Simple to his
and their use and behoof forever. And I the said James M.
Landrum for myself, heirs and assigns do covenant to war-
rant and forever quit claim unto the said Silas Ferrigan
his heirs and assigns forever in the peaceable and quiet enjoyment
of the same.
