to me in hand paid by Frederick D. Beal of the State of Florida
expressed, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
conferred, have given granted, bargained and sold and do
by these presents give grant bargain sell and convey unto
the said Beal his heirs and assigns, the following real
estate lying and being situate in said State and County
to wit: One fourth East quarter of one fourth West quarter of
Section twenty one - South half of one fourth West quarter
of Section twenty two the whole East quarter of one fourth
West quarter of Section twenty two all of Section fourteen,
the West half of one fourth West quarter Section eleven, the East
half Section two, the South East quarter of one fourth West quarter
of Section thirty six, West half South East quarter Section
eleven, the South East quarter of one fourth East quarter Section
fifteen, also all my interest in lands held from the
Pompano & Louisville Rail Road Company Feb. 2nd 1874
by the said Beal and by him conveyed to me by deed of
July 2nd 1874. containing about Six hundred and forty
acres, together with all and singular the improvements
of any kind whatsoever, and above mentioned lands
