one, the South half of North West quarter of section twenty  
two, the North East quarter of North West quarter of section  
twenty two all of section fourteen, West half of South West quarter  
of section eleven, East half of section two, South East quarter  
of North West quarter of section thirty six, West half of  
South East quarter of section eleven, South East quarter  
of North West quarter section fifteen all lying in Town  
ship two north Range thirty west, also all our  
interest in lands leased from Remainder and Louisville  
Rail Road Company by F. O. Beal Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> 1874 and  
by him conveyed to us by deed of even date, herein set
