The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant, bargain sell and convey unto James Greary, Cyrus Snodgrass and Thomas H. Ellis, as Trustees of the Presbyterian Church at Blackwater Fla in connection with the General assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States in trust, and their successors forever the following described piece or parcel of Land to wit: known as Lot number four of Block number Twenty nine, as laid down on a Map of the Village of Blackwater drawn by Lee and Davison, and on file in the office of Simpson & Co. and bounded as follows, beginning at the Southwesterly corner of Main and Church Street, running thence Southwesterly along the westerly line of Church Street two hundred and eighty feet to the corner of Church and Allen Street thence Westerly along the westerly side of Allen Street, one hundred and fifty feet thence Northerly along the westerly line of said lot, to a stake on Main Street two hundred and seventy five feet and six inches, thence easterly along the southerly line of Main Street, to the place of beginning, one hundred feet. - to have and hold unto the said James Greary, Cyrus Snodgrass, and Thomas H.
