In money to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents doth give unto the said party of second part all of my crop of corn and Rice Potatoes &c. all etc., rights, interest claims mortgages, as well as all other equity to have and hold.

This grant is intended as a security for the payment of two notes one for eleven hundred and twenty lbs. corn and Six Dollars and sixty cts. bearing even date, with this if payment is fully made will render this conveyance void otherwise in full force if payment of the above mentioned is not paid by the first day of September, then the said party of the second part or his assigns are authorized to take and sell said crop of corn, Rice, Potatoes &c. also much beef as will fully pay the above mentioned notes in money.
