Now if said Note shall be paid at maturity by said McHain, then this instrument, to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue. And it is further agreed, by & between the parties, here to that the said McHain & wife, fully covenant to the alienation of all the above said property, and that they the said McHain and wife will pay all expenses attending a foreclosure of this instrument, provided a foreclosure should be necessary.
