- 5. The time of holding elections for said officers shall be on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January of each succeeding year, unless the same shall fall on a Sunday, in which it shall be held on the day previous and the method of the election, shall be by vote a majority of the voting being necessary to a choice.
- 6. Each member of the Society shall be punctuated at the meetings appointed and shall pay for the benefit of said Society, twenty five cents monthly.

The foregoing proceedings being had it was moved and resolved that the meeting adjourn to meet again on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January A D 1876. Where motion was carried.
