paid by R. Milligan & J. Choffin partners trading &
doing business under the name & style Milligan
& Choffin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents
do bargain sell and convey unto the said Milligan & Choffin
their heirs and assigns the following described personal property
to wit: six oxen described as follows one a Cow Red br. named
Sam, one a Roosty Collier named Brandy, one white named Jerry,
one white with Cur jaws named Bright one Black Red named
Larry, one yellow head br. named Buck one Log Cart 6 feet
8 inches high five inches wide. Two rollers, three yokes with
chains & bells, iron axle, Capped with wood and all necessary
equipage for running the same. I have and to hold the above
described property unto the said Milligan & Choffin their heirs
and assigns forever. yet upon this condition that whereas the
said Fisher Dixon is indebted to the said Milligan and Choffin
