the above bounden John D Leigh has been appointed County Treasurer
for the County of Santa Rosa to hold his office for two years from
the Twenty First Day of March AD 1877 the day of his appointment

Now if the said John D Leigh shall render a correct and faithful
account of all moneys that may come into his possession or control
by virtue of his said office and faithfully perform all the duties
of his said office as prescribed by law this obligation to be void
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
