The Superintendent of Schools Deion H. Tolson called the meeting to order and on motion, William Johnson was elected Chairman. As the Superintendent of Schools is by virtue of his office made Secretary of the Board, the organization was announced complete. and the Board adjourned to meet at the call of the Secretary.

Know all men by these presents that we David Blackshear and Margaret E. Blackshear his wife who joins her said husband in the execution of the deed for the purpose of relinquishing her right and title to some in the land hereinafter described for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by William H. Garrison (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have given, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell, convey and deliver unto the said William H. Garrison his heirs and assigns the following described lot or parcel of land lying and being situate in the Town of Melton State and County aforesaid. To wit: Range 6, part of Section Section Three (3) in Township One North, Range Twenty Eight (28) West, adjoining Black Water River on the East and better known as the Benjamin Marshall place and, also adjoining the Township line dividing Township one & two North of said Range and containing Ten Acres (10) more or less except the following portion of said lot which was conveyed by said Blackshear and wife to Mrs Elizabeth C. Leonard wife of Stark S. Leonard by deed dated August 6<sup>th</sup> 1875 and described in said deed as follows: Commencing at a point where the north East corner of said lot joins the Township line between Township one & two thence along the line of said lot two hundred feet and twenty five (225) feet thence due East on a line parallel with said River said Township line to the Black Water River thence along the margin of said River to a point
